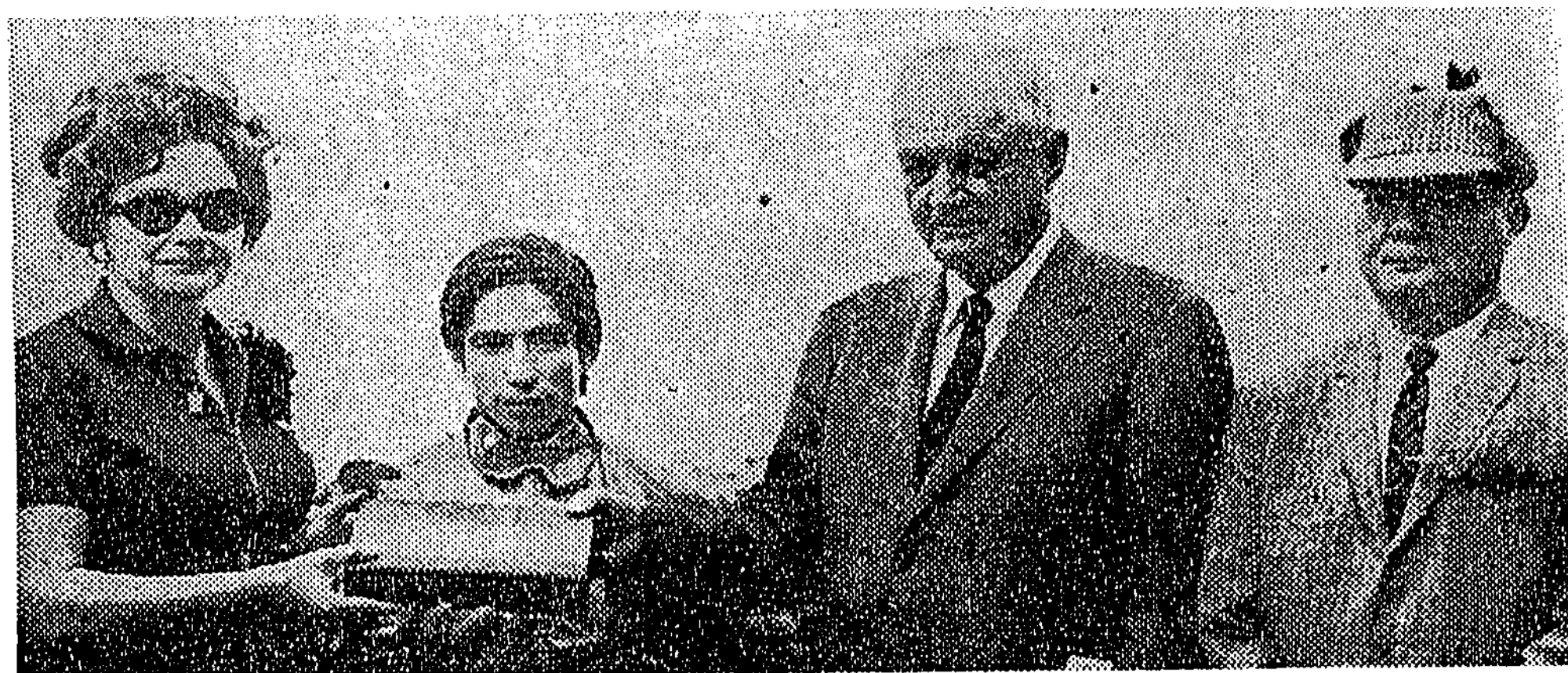


# Royal Picnic Foils the 'Irregulars'

Time was running out, and none of the Baker Street Irregulars had come up with a solid clue that would point out the winner of yesterday's Silver Blaze Purse at Belmont Park.

"How about Royal Picnic?" said one of the Irregulars, a group dedicated to preserving the memory of Sherlock Holmes. "The old boy had a lot of picnics with royalty."

"That would be stretching it," said Tom Stix Sr., whose efforts 20 years ago helped make the Silver Blaze an annual race here. "You look for red and black silks, but there's only pink and black in today's field. That's no good. We're purists."

Forty-nine Irregulars and guests turned out for the 20th running of the Silver Blaze, a race named for the famous mystery story dealing with the horse Silver Blaze, his disappearance, the murder of his trainer, and his recovery by Holmes in time to win the Wessex Plate. The members wore red carnations tied with black bows, the racing colors of Silver Blaze's owner, Colonel Ross.

## Hunches Galore

Silver Blaze was No. 4, but the Irregulars didn't fancy the chances of the 4 horse in yesterday's race, Creeque Alley.

"Wait a minute," said Stix, fingering a red-striped black tie. "How about Lily Pad?"

"The Jersey Lily," somebody said, nodding. "Irene Adler in 'Scandal in Bohemia,' the only woman who ever outsmarted Holmes."

Unfortunately for the Irregulars, form held up better than hunches in the seven-furlong grass race for fillies and mares. Royal Picnic, the filly who wasn't enough of a hunch, won the event as the 1-to-2 favorite of a crowd of 18,914. Finest Deb ran second, half a length back, and Lily Pad finished a distant third.

Royal Picnic, owned by Greentree Stable, covered the distance on a soft course in 1:25 1/5 and gave Laffit Pincay Jr. his third riding victory of the day. Pincay won the second race with Queenpot (\$11.40) and the third with Jr.'s Arrowhead (\$6.60). Royal Picnic returned \$3.

Dr. Julian Wolff, president

of the Baker Street organization, wore the historic deerstalker hat in the winner's circle as a first edition of "Silver Blaze" and other mysteries by the late Sir Arthur Conan Doyle was presented to John Gaver, the Greentree trainer.

The race would have produced a major embarrassment for the Irregulars, who totally overlooked a filly named Swinging Lizzie. Sired by the

Axe II, Swinging Lizzie obviously was named for Lizzie Borden and the unsolved Fall River murder mystery of the 1890's.

Dr. Watson probably wouldn't have spotted the clue, and neither did any of the Irregulars. Swinging Lizzie, blocked on the turn, had to settle for fourth. Had she won it, Holmes might never have forgiven his followers.
